Frequently Asked Questions about VCA's Tuition Assistance Program

Why does VCA offer Tuition Assistance?

We strongly feel that according to God's Word, all Christian children belong in an educational system where Jesus Christ is pre-eminent (Colossians 1:18) and where they are taught to love the Lord their god with all their heart (Deuteronomy 6:5-7). Because of this, Valley Christian Academy provides a Tuition Assistance program.

Will I qualify for Tuition Assistance?

Tuition Assistance is awarded based on need and available funds.

How do I apply?

Each year, you must obtain a Tuition Assistance packet, fill it out completely, and submit all required paperwork to the VCA Business Office.

Is there a cost?

There is a \$30 online processing fee payable directly to DTS, the outside firm that is instrumental in establishing the family financial need.

How long will it take to go through the application process?

The paperwork will take some time and energy on your part to complete.

When is the deadline?

The application deadline is April 15 of each year in order to be considered for the main disbursement of Tuition Assistance Funds. Tuition Assistance can be awarded at various other times of the year if funds are still available.

Do I have to re-apply each year?

Yes.

How is the decision made as to how much I'll receive?

Available funds will be distributed to the families with the greatest financial need.

How confidential is all of this information?

Only the Tuition Assistance Committee members see the applications. Administration and Faculty are not aware of who receives Tuition Assistance.

How many students at VCA receive Tuition Assistance?

22% of VCA students receive Tuition Assistance.
